# WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM INVOLVE?

HELD FROM FEBRUARY TO DECEMBER EACH YEAR, THE PROGRAM SOURCES PARTICIPANTS FROM ACROSS THE REGION'S DIVERSE BUSINESS, GOVERNMENT AND COMMUNITY SECTORS. PLACES ARE LIMITED, AND A ROBUST SELECTION PROCESS ENSURES PARTICIPANTS ARE GENUINE ABOUT THEIR LEADERSHIP JOURNEY AND THAT THEY'RE DRAWN FROM DIVERSE BACKGROUNDS.

Through a vibrant schedule of guest speakers, workshops and activities, participants learn about themselves and expand their knowledge and leadership abilities. They also work together to design and implement exciting community projects linked to the Great South Coast Strategic Plan, providing an opportunity to apply the skills they are learning in unfamiliar contexts.

By the end of the program, participants will be more self-aware, with an abundance of new skills and knowledge and exciting new networks. Combined, these help to dramatically enhance their careers, personal life and connectedness to their community.

## WHAT'S THE FINANCIAL INVESTMENT?

### LEADERSHIP GREAT SOUTH COAST OPERATES ON THE GENEROSITY OF PROGRAM PARTNERS AND GOVERNMENT.

With the exception of scholarship recipients, we ask each participant to pay a fee of \$3300 + GST. Employers may cover this investment in full or in part.

In return, program participants undertake a unique learning journey valued in excess of \$8000.

We do not believe that financial hardship should prevent any person from applying to the program. Fees can be negotiated and paid over a period of time. Information and assistance is available for scholarship applications and sponsorship.
